- Final 2 shows on Sat. March 26 at the Center for the Arts at Wesley Chapel. Act I for solos through 12 years old and younger groups at 12 noon; Act II for older students, solos & groups at 7 pm.
- Tickets available at the door: \$12 for adults or both shows for \$20; students through high school are \$6 or both shows for \$10 (under 5 is free).
- 200 students auditioned on Feb. 19 to be named finalists.
- 139 contestants performing to win over \$2,000 in trophies, ribbons and cash prizes.
- Public invited – performances of all styles of piano and vocal music, all types of dance, instrumentals include classical guitar, electric guitar, and violin.
- Visual arts competition & show included.
- Panels of paid, professional judges will select winners of cash prizes.
